"except that the following item shall be added to Table D under the heading 'Major Equipment, Building and Civil Engineering Works' –

with an increase in the amount to be withdrawn from the consolidated fund from £34,587,000 to £44,587,000".

THE STATES granted leave of Deputy Shona Pitman to withdraw her amendment to the amendment of Deputy Geoffrey Peter Southern of St. Helier that in paragraph (d) of the Draft Annual Business Plan 2010, for the figure "£10,000,000" under the heading 'Proposed Allocation' there should be substituted the figure "£12,000,000" and for the figure "£44,587,000" there should be substituted the figure "£46,587,000".

## Adjournment

THE STATES adjourned, having adopted a proposition of the Connétable of St Mary that it would reconvene at 9.30 a.m. on Friday 25th September 2009 and adhere to the usual hours of business.
