#### Criminal Injuries Compensation Scheme: revised Scheme P.13/2015

THE STATES, adopting a proposition of the Minister for Home Affairs, referred to their Act dated 2nd May 2012 in which they approved a revised Criminal Injuries Compensation Scheme, and agreed the following amendments to that Scheme –

- (ii) in paragraph 25(a) after the words "immediately preceding the date of death" there should be added the words "such compensation being payable to the extent and on the conditions set out in respect of damages under the Fatal Accidents (Jersey) Law 1962;";
- (iii) in paragraph 28, after sub-paragraph (b) there should be inserted the following subparagraph:
  "(c) income support payable under the Income Support (Jersey) Law 2007;"; and the remaining sub-paragraph should be renumbered as "(d)".
