# **DRAFT CONTROL OF HOUSING AND WORK (TRANSITIONAL AND CONSEQUENTIAL PROVISIONS) (No. 2) (JERSEY) REGULATIONS 201-**

## **REPORT**

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These Regulations support a streamlined approach to the introduction of the new Control of Housing and Work (Jersey) Law 2012 on 1st July 2013.

In particular, employers have been accustomed, for many years, to making returns of their staffing levels as at 31st December and 30th June each year to the Population Office under the Regulation of Undertakings and Development (Jersey) Law 1973.

These Regulations ensure that the returns from employers for 30th June 2013 continue to be due, and that collection requirements continue to remain applicable, under the existing tried and tested return methods. The first return under the new Law will then relate to 31st December 2013.

These Regulations also deal with a minor consequential amendment to the Residential Tenancy (Jersey) Law 2011, such that that Law refers to the new Control of Housing and Work (Jersey) Law 2012.

### **Financial and manpower implications**

There are no additional financial or manpower implications arising from the adoption of these draft Regulations.

## Explanatory Note

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These Regulations make a further transitional provision and consequential provision in respect of the commencement of the Control of Housing and Work (Jersey) Law 2012.

*Regulation 1* provides that, notwithstanding the repeal of the Regulation of Undertakings and Development (Jersey) Law 1973 (“1973 Law”) by the Control of Housing and Work (Jersey) Law 2012, Article 3 of the 1973 Law and the Order relating to manpower returns, that is, the Regulation of Undertakings and Development (Return of Employers) (Jersey) Order 2001 (“Order”), shall continue in force for the purposes of the requirements relating to the completion and return of manpower returns by 15th July 2013. Article 3 of the 1973 Law requires manpower returns to be furnished to the Minister with such information and at such times as may be prescribed. The Order sets out the information that is required and requires returns to be completed within 15 days of the 30th December and 30th June each year.

*Regulation 2* makes a consequential amendment to the Residential Tenancy (Jersey) Law 2011 so as to substitute a reference to the Control of Housing and Work (Jersey) Law 2012 for a reference to the Housing (Jersey) Law 1949.

*Regulation 3* sets out the title of these Regulations and provides that they will come into force on the same day as the Control of Housing and Work (Jersey) Law 2012.

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of Article 52 of the Control of Housing and Work (Jersey) Law 2012<sup>1</sup>, have made the following Regulations –

**1 Transitional provision in respect of manpower returns relating to undertakings**

- (1) Regulation 3 of the RUD Law and the Regulation of Undertakings and Development (Return of Employers) (Jersey) Order 2001<sup>2</sup> shall continue to be in force for the purposes of requirements relating to the completion and return of manpower returns by 15th July 2013, notwithstanding the repeal of the RUD Law by Article 51 of the Control of Housing and Work (Jersey) Law 2012<sup>3</sup>.
- (2) In this Article “RUD Law” means the Regulation of Undertakings and Development (Jersey) Law 1973<sup>4</sup>.

**2 Consequential amendment to the Residential Tenancy (Jersey) Law 2011**

In Article 18 of the Residential Tenancy (Jersey) Law 2011<sup>5</sup> –

- (a) in the heading for the words “Housing Law” there shall be substituted the words “Control of Housing and Work Law”;
- (b) in paragraph (1) for the words “Housing (Jersey) Law 1949<sup>6</sup>” there shall be substituted the words “Control of Housing and Work (Jersey) Law 2012<sup>7</sup>”.

**3 Citation and commencement**

These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Housing and Work (Transitional and Consequential Provisions) (No. 2) (Jersey) Regulations 201- and shall come into force on the same date that the Control of Housing and Work (Jersey) Law 2012 comes into force.
