

PARISH ASSEMBLIES: INFORMATION PACK (P.60/2011)

PROPOSITION (AS ADOPTED BY THE STATES)

THE STATES are asked to decide whether they are of opinion –

to request the Comité des Connétables to investigate the possibility of –

- (a) creating a booklet which would be available to all parishioners in each parish by **31st January 2012** setting out, amongst other things –
 - (i) how a parish assembly works;
 - (ii) what constitutes a parish assembly;
 - (iii) how parishioners can add matters to an agenda;
 - (iv) what they have to do to in the event that they want to call a parish assembly;
 - (v) how and whether propositions without prior notice may be made during a parish assembly;
 - (vi) how and whether amendments may be submitted to a proposition;
 - (vii) who may vote at a parish assembly;
 - (viii) a list of parish officials and how they are appointed/elected;
 - (ix) any further information relating to the operation of parish assemblies and the appointment of parochial officials that the Comité deems relevant;
- (b) publishing a standardized set of recommended procedures for use in all 12 parishes, setting out how a parish assembly should be conducted.
