**Question**

“Will the Chair advise whether the two non-executive members of the Board (Deputy S.M. Ahier of St. Helier North and the Connétable of St. Clement) were involved in the discussions and subsequent agreement of the pay award for teachers; and, if not, why not?”

**Answer**

The first meeting of the States Employment Board took place on 5<sup>th</sup> February 2024 shortly after the election of the new Council of Ministers, and sat with a quorum comprising the Chief Minister, Deputy Malcolm Ferey and Deputy Rose Binet. The meeting approved the revised pay offer to teachers. The two non-executive members of the Board were appointed at a later date and were provided with an update on the teachers’ pay negotiations.
