# Rules



## Competition Rules

1. The competition is open to all students in Jersey aged between 5-11. There are two categories:
  - Key Stage 1 students in Years 1 and 2
  - Key Stage 2 students in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6
2. Entries can be created in any medium: collages, drawings, paintings or even computer-generated but should be no bigger than A3.
3. By entering you give the States Greffe the right to publish your design.
4. Entries should have the student's name, school and year group / class clearly written on it.
5. The judges' decision is final.
6. The deadline for entries is **Friday 6 October at 5pm.**
