- The winner of each category will win a day trip to London, with a parent/guardian, to visit Westminster and have a tour around the UK's parliament.



Rules



Competition Rules

- 1. The competition is open to all students in Jersey aged between 5-11. There are two categories:
 - Key Stage 1 students in Years 1 and 2
 - Key Stage 2 students in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6
- 2. Entries can be created in any medium: collages, drawings, paintings or even computer-generated but should be no bigger than A3.
- 3. By entering you give the States Greffe the right to publish your design.
- 4. Entries should have the student's name, school and year group / class clearly written on it.
- 5. The judges' decision is final.
- 6. The deadline for entries is Friday 6 October at 5pm.
