These are the reasons for this petition –

There is currently no pavement on La Grande Route de Guernesey, St. Mary, between its junction with La Rue d'Aurigny and Le Chemin de Sercq which means that pedestrians are placed at considerable risk along this stretch of road, with one child being injured in a road traffic accident in June 2006.

We, the undersigned, petition the States of Jersey as follows –

The Minister for Transport and Technical Services is requested to take the necessary steps to establish a pavement on La Grande Route de Guernesey, St. Mary, between its junction with La Rue d'Aurigny and Le Chemin de Sercq to improve safety for pedestrians in this area.
