Etat Civil Committee – appointment of President.

Draft States of Jersey (Amendment No.) Law, 198: Report. P.57/83.

The Legislation Committee by Act dated 5th April, 1983, presented to the States a Report on the draft States of Jersey (Amendment No.) Law, 198 (P.157/82 – lodged on 16th November, 1982).

THE STATES ordered that the said Report be printed and distributed.

Health Insurance Exception Scheme extension: Report. P.58/83.

The Finance and Economics Committee by Act dated 6th April, 1983, presented to the States a Report on the Proposition regarding the extension of the Health Insurance Exception Scheme (P.29/83 – lodged on 1st March, 1983).

THE STATES ordered that the said Report be printed and distributed.

Draft Protection of Employment Opportunities (Jersey) Law, 198.

THE STATES continued consideration of the draft Protection of Employment Opportunities (Jersey) Law, 198 (P.36/83 – lodged on 15th March, 1983) and adopted Articles 1, 4, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12. Articles 2, 3, 5 and 7 were referred back to the Defence Committee together with the amendments to Article 7 proposed by the Connétable of St. Saviour (P.47/83 – lodged on 29th March, 1983).

Britannia House, Mont Mado, St. John.

THE STATES, adopting a Proposition of the Housing Committee –

- (a) approved Drawings No. 2728/9, 2728/10 and 2728/11 showing the redevelopment of Britannia House, Mont Mado, St. John to provide 2 two-bedroomed units, 2 three-bedroomed units and 1 four-bedroomed unit of accommodation;
- (b) authorised the Greffier of the States to sign the said Drawings on behalf of the States.

Police Force (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Law, 1982 (Commencement) Act, 1983.
