4. **Perrot Hall, Victoria Street, St. Helier: purchase and redevelopment. P.153/85.**
Presented by the Housing Committee. The States decided to take this subject into consideration on 10th December, 1985.

Post of Chief Executive Officer, States Personnel Department. Questions and answer.

Senator Richard Joseph Shenton asked Deputy Sir Martin Le Quesne of St. Saviour, President of the Establishment Committee, the following questions –

“Will the President inform the House –

1. How many applications were received for the post of Chief Executive Officer of the States Personnel Department?
2. How many applicants were interviewed?”

The President of the Establishment Committee replied as follows –

Licensing (No. 4) (Jersey) Regulations, 1985. P.31/85.

THE STATES commenced consideration of the draft Licensing (No. 4) (Jersey) Regulations, 198 (lodged on 2nd April, 1985) and adopted the Preamble.

Article 1 was adopted.

Article 2 was adopted, the States having accepted an amendment of the Tourism Committee that for the words “forthwith on promulgation” there should be substituted the words “on the first day of January, 1986”.

Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) (Amendment No. 7) (Jersey) Regulations, 1985. P.141/85.

THE STATES, in pursuance of the Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) (Jersey) Law, 1953, made Regulations entitled the Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) (Amendment No. 7) (Jersey) Regulations, 1985.

Government House: staff accommodation. P.131/85.

THE STATES, adopting a Proposition of the Public Works Committee, approved the provision of new staff accommodation at Government House by –

- (a) the building of two pairs of semi-detached houses to re-house the families at present occupying accommodation in the stable block;
- (b) following the construction and occupation of the new semi-detached houses, the refurbishing of the stable block and its conversion to provide at first floor level bedroom or bed-sit units for staff at present accommodated in the main house and at ground floor level, garages plus a gardener's office, toilets and stores.

Hawkers and Non-Resident Traders (Amendment) (Jersey) Law, 1985. P.132/85.
