Strategic Policy 1991. P.81/91 and
P.95/91

THE STATES continued consideration
of the report and proposition of the Policy
and Resources Committee on Strategic Policy
1991.

THE STATES accepted an amendment of Senator
Nigel Lewis Querée that in paragraph 5.18
of the report after the word
"safeguarded" there should be inserted
the words "There is an urgent need to
evaluate the contribution of materials
presently used for land reclamation which
could be re-used or processed for re-use."

After discussion the States adopted the
following further amendments of Senator
Querée -

For sub-paragraph 5.20(ii) of the

report there should be substituted -

- ``(ii) the reduction of the total volume of refuse by policies which either discourage or outlaw excess packaging, 'throw-away' items, non-returnable bottles, etc. Policies shall also be developed to encourage the recycling of a high proportion of the materials that remain in the waste stream.

To assist the setting up of recycling operations, the Policy and Resources Committee will consider revenue support equivalent to a proportion of the money saved by Public Services and the Parishes."

and that for sub-paragraph 5.20(iv) there should be substituted -

- ``(iv) reducing the volume of non-combustible refuse by encouraging the processing and re-use of these materials, with financial support if necessary in proportion to the money saved by the States in providing tipping space."

After further discussion Senator Querée withdrew his proposed amendments to sub-paragraphs 5.20(vi) and 5.30(viii).

THE STATES thereupon adopted the proposition of the Policy and Resources Committee and -

- (1) accepted the 1991 Strategic Policy Report of the Policy and Resources Committee, as amended, as a general statement of the policy objectives towards which all Committees will have regard;
- (2) (a) agreed that the States' capital programme for 1992 should comprise
