States of Jersey Complaints Board - findings: complaint against a decision of the Minister for Education, Sport and Culture relating to a nursery school place. 1386/2/1/3(13) **Encl.**  A1. The Committee received and considered a report from the States of Jersey Complaints Board on the findings of a complaint against a decision of the Minister for Education, Sport and Culture relating to a nursery school place.

The Committee was advised that in accordance with Article 9(9) of the Administrative Decisions (Review) (Jersey) Law 1982, as amended, it was required to present to the States a copy of the report from the States of Jersey Complaints Board.

The Committee noted that the Complaints Board had been convened to review a complaint made by Ms. M. McCartney against a decision of the Minister for Education, Sport and Culture not to offer a nursery place for her child at St. Martin's Primary School, or elsewhere.
