Status of Jèrriais within the States Assembly. 465/4(27) A1. The Committee, with reference to its Minute No. B7 of 5th December 2017, received an updated report to accompany the draft Proposition, relating to the status of Jèrriais within the States Assembly, which it had previously approved.

The Committee recalled that it wished to keep Jèrriais alive and proposed to allow States Members the option to use Jèrriais during proceedings in the States Chamber, with the *caveat* that the Presiding Officer could require the speaker to provide a translation into English.
