The Committee received a list of forthcoming business for debate by the States Assembly at its meetings to be held on 20th November 2018 and 4th December 2018.</p> <p>The Committee recalled that it had already presented a comment on the Proposition of Deputy G.C.U. Guida of St. Lawrence, 'Public Impact of Propositions: proposed amendments to Standing Orders' (P.96/2018) and decided that it did not wish, at this juncture, to comment on any other items for debate on those dates. However, it was suggested that the Comité des Connétables and the Minister for Home Affairs might be reminded to comment on the amendment of Senator S.C. Ferguson to P.96/2018, which mooted that every proposition should also be accompanied, where appropriate, by an estimate of the cost and practicality of policing, or enforcing the substance of the proposition.</p> <p>However, it was ultimately determined that it was a matter for those aforementioned to decide whether to comment or not.</p> |
