"(b) that the Privileges and Procedures Committee should institute an independent process for periodic review of the boundaries of districts within parishes so that, as far as possible, the districts within a parish each contain the same numbers of people, with a view to bringing forward amendments to the States of Jersey Law 2005 to change district boundaries in line with the recommendations of this work".

In paragraph (c) the words "and create an independent Boundaries Commission" should be deleted.
