Election	The Committee recalled that the legislative changes had been brought forward

The Committee recalled that the legislative changes had been brought forward following the work undertaken by the Election Observers Sub-Committee on proposals for electoral reform.

The Committee was advised that the legislative changes would implement paragraph (a) of P.139/2020, namely, to establish an Assembly of 49 Members, 37 elected from 9 new districts of comparable population size, plus the 12 Parish Connétables. The legislation would also move the date of the next election to June 2022.

The Committee approved the draft Proposition and instructed the Principal Committee and Panel Officer to make the necessary arrangements for it to be presented to the Assembly as soon as practicable.
