THE IRAQ (UNITED NATIONS SANCTIONS) (CHANNEL ISLANDS) ORDER 2003

The above-mentioned Order, which was made by Her Majesty in Council, by and with the advice of the

Privy Council, on 12th June 2003, was registered in the Royal Court on 4th July 2003 and came into force on

14th June 2003.

The effect of the Order, which is made in pursuance of section 1 of the United Nations Act 1946, is to

prohibit the supply of arms and related material in Iraq or the carriage of goods to a place in Iraq, unless

authorized by a licence; to provide for the return of illegally removed Iraqi cultural property; to confer

privileges and immunities upon the development fund for Iraq and for petroleum, petroleum products and

natural as originating in Iraq; and to amend the Iraq (United Nations Sanctions) (Channel Islands) Order 2000.
