CRIME (GOING EQUIPPED) (JERSEY) LAW 2003

The above-mentioned Law (L.10 of 2003), which was adopted by the States on 24th September 2002 and sanctioned by Her Majesty in Council on 17th February 2003, was registered in the Royal Court today and comes into force on 28th March 2003.

The purpose of the Law is to make it an offence to "go equipped" with any article with the intent that it be used with the intent to commit a specified offence. The offences specified include larceny, breaking and entering, taking a vehicle without consent and fraud.

SUBORDINATE LEGISLATION (AMENDMENT No. 3) (JERSEY) LAW 2003

The above-mentioned Law (L.13 of 2003), which was adopted by the States on 12th November 2002 and sanctioned by Her Majesty in Council on 27th February 2003, was registered in the Royal Court today and comes into force on 28th March 2003.

The purpose of the Law is to apply the Subordinate Legislation (Jersey) Law 1960, which enables a member of the States to bring a proposition for annulment of subordinate legislation, to all subordinate legislation, unless expressly disapplied.

CIVIL EVIDENCE (JERSEY) LAW 2003

The above-mentioned Law (L.14 of 2003), which was adopted by the States on 24th September 2002 and sanctioned by Her Majesty in Council on 27th February 2003, was registered in the Royal Court today and comes into force on such day as the States may by Act appoint.

The purpose of the Law is to provide for the admission of hearsay evidence and proof of documentary evidence in civil proceedings.

DOGS (AMENDMENT No. 2) (JERSEY) LAW 2003

The above-mentioned Law (L.15 of 2003), which was adopted by the States on 5th November 2002 and sanctioned by Her Majesty in Council on 27th February 2003, was registered in the Royal Court today and

comes into force on 28th March 2003.

The purpose of the Law is to remove the requirement for a dog licence to be held for a "hearing dog for the deaf" and enables future exemptions from the licensing requirements to be specified by regulations.

INTERPRETATION (AMENDMENT) (JERSEY) LAW 2003

The above-mentioned Law (L.16 of 2003), which was adopted by the States on 12th November 2002 and sanctioned by Her Majesty in Council on 27th February 2003, was registered in the Royal Court today and comes into force on 28th March 2003.

The purpose of the Law is to clarify the time when certain legislation comes into force and apply new rules for construction and definitions to all legislation.

OFFICIAL PUBLICATIONS (AMENDMENT) (JERSEY) LAW 2003

The above-mentioned Law (L.17 of 2003), which was adopted by the States on 12th November 2002 and sanctioned by Her Majesty in Council on 27th February 2003, was registered in the Royal Court today and comes into force on 28th March 2003.

The purpose of the Law is to enable, where appropriate, statutory notices of certain matters to be given other than through the medium of the Jersey Gazette.

PARISH RATE (ADMINISTRATION) (JERSEY) LAW 2003

The above-mentioned Law (L.18 of 2003), which was adopted by the States on 5th December 2002 and sanctioned by Her Majesty in Council on 27th February 2003, was registered in the Royal Court today and comes into force on 1st January 2004.

The purpose of the Law is to provide for the manner in which a Parish may levy a rate, to prescribe how a Parish shall apply the proceeds of a rate and for related matters.
