R&O 10/2006

This Order permits the Jersey Motor Cycle and Light Car Club to hold sand races, and practices for sand races, on the St. Ouer's Beach course, the West Park course, and the Millbrook course, on various dates in 2006.

The Order was made on 27th January 2006, and comes into force on 3rd February 2006.

R&O 11/2006

This Order authorizes the Jersey Motor Cycle and Light Car Club to –

- (a) hold sprint races around the Five Mile Road course, and to close roads for that purpose, on 18th March, 17th June and 30th September 2006 between 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m.; and
- (b) hold hill climbs on the Bouley Bay Hill course, and to close roads for that purpose, on 17th April, 9th May, 13th July and 28th August 2006 between 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m.
