- “What is the Minister’s assessment of whether the combination of pay levels, shift patterns, policies for payment of travel time and terms for sick leave, as well as the use of zero-hour contracts, gives rise to health and safety concerns in the delivery of home care to clients in Jersey; and, if the assessment is that there are no such concerns, why is that the case?”
