Comments

The Finance and Economics Committee has noted that the cost of the House Committee's proposals in respect of income support would be £336,000, and in respect of Senator Shenton's proposition £516,500.

The Finance and Economics Committee recognises that income support and refunding of Class 2 social security contributions is a matter for the States to decide, although it should be noted that any increase in the payment to States' members will have to be funded through the general reserve.
