# DRAFT DATA PROTECTION (REGULATION OF FINANCIAL SERVICES, ETC.) (SUBJECT ACCESS EXEMPTION) (AMENDMENT No. 3) (JERSEY) REGULATIONS 199

#### Report

Under the Data Protection (Jersey) Law 1987, personal data held on a computer system must be available to the person concerned; in other words the subject must have access.

Article 29 of the Data Protection (Jersey) Law 1987 provides that personal data held for the purpose of discharging functions relating to the regulation of financial services to which an exemption applies is exempt from the subject access provisions of that Law in any case in which the application of those provisions to the data would be likely to prejudice the proper discharge of those functions.

The Finance and Economics Committee, when it carries out various functions in relation to the regulation of financial services, is at present so exempt under existing regulations. The functions of the Committee in that connection are to be transferred on 1st July 1998 to the new Jersey Financial Services Commission. The new Regulations are required so as to provide continuing exemption from subject access.

The Regulations also restate the exemption for the Viscount in relation to his duties under the Bankruptcy (Désastre) (Jersey) Law 1990.

The purpose of the Regulations is to ensure that data held on individuals who have a relationship with regulated entities or entities that should be regulated, cannot be accessed by those individuals who may be subject to review or investigation by the Commission.

At the same time, the opportunity has been taken to bring the Regulations into line with current international practice including that of the United Kingdom. The Regulations are now more specific in specifying the functions which carry exemptions by reference to particular Articles of each regulatory law, as opposed to each regulatory law in general.

The exempted information will only be held by the Jersey Financial Services Commission (as of now by the Financial Services Department) in connection with the functions which are "designed for protecting members of the public against financial loss due to dishonesty, incompetence or malpractice by persons concerned in the provision of banking, insurance investment or other financial services or in the management of companies or to the conduct of discharged or undischarged bankrupts" (Article 29 of the 1987 Law).

### **Explanatory Note**

The purpose of these Regulations is to replace the Schedule to the Data Protection (Regulation of Financial Services, etc.) (Subject Access Exemption) (Jersey) Regulations 1987 as a result of a number of changes in the legislation and functions to which the replaced Schedule refers as well as the passing of further legislation.

Among those changes are the transfer of certain powers of the Finance and Economics Committee to the Jersey Financial Services Commission as a consequence of the enactment of the Financial Services Commission Law 1998. This Law sets up the Commission as a statutory body corporate with functions that include the supervision of various financial services in Jersey. This instrument is one of a number that make corresponding changes to subordinate legislation that contains references to the Committee.

1. For the Schedule to the Data Protection (Regulation of Financial Services, etc.) (Subject Access Exemption) (Jersey) Regulations 1987,<sup>2</sup> as amended,<sup>3</sup> there shall be substituted the following Schedule -

**2.** These Regulations may be cited as the Data Protection (Regulation of Financial Services, etc.) (Subject Access Exemption) (Amendment No. 3) (Jersey) Regulations 1998 and shall come into force on the first day of July 1998.
