## Report

Given that the States did not follow the recommendations of the remuneration board and decided to support Senator Shenton's amendment, it must also be right that **NO** backdating of income support takes place.

Given that an 18-month backdate would amount to approximately £15,000 per member who claim income support and a six-month backdate would be some £5,000, that on top of a 65 per cent increase in income support is totally unacceptable, and I believe that no States member could justify this.
