Explanatory Note

These Regulations amend the Harbours (Jersey) Regulations 1961 so as to provide a permit system governing the use of harbour ramps for the loading and unloading of vehicles on or from vessels.

The Regulations insert a new Regulation 1B into the 1961 Regulations. This prohibits an operator from using a ramp at any harbour for the loading and unloading of vehicles on or from his vessel without a valid permit issued by the Committee. The Committee may issue permits subject to such terms and conditions as it thinks fit and any person who contravenes the Regulation or the provisions of a permit is liable to a fine not exceeding level 4 on the standard scale (level 1 = £50, level 2 = £500, level 3 = £2,000, level 4 = £5,000).

The Regulations come into force on 1st January 1999.

1. After Regulation 1A of the Harbours (Jersey) Regulations 1962, as amended, there shall be inserted the following Regulation -

"Permits for the use of ramps at harbours

- 1B.-(1) No operator of a vessel shall use any ramp at a harbour for the loading and unloading of vehicles on or from that vessel unless he holds a valid permit issued by the Committee under this Regulation.
- (2) The Committee may issue permits subject to such terms and conditions as it thinks fit.
- (3) If any person contravenes this Regulation or any provision of a permit issued thereunder he shall be liable to a fine not exceeding level 4 on the standard scale.".

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Harbours (Amendment No. 29) (Jersey) Regulations 199 and shall come into force on the first day of January 1999.
