Explanatory Note

The purpose of this draft Law is to -

- (a) amend the Post Office (Jersey) Law 1969 to empower the Committee for Postal Administration to make Orders prescribing postal charges which raise income in excess of that required by the Committee to discharge its functions under that Law (*Article 1 and First Schedule*); and
- (b) validate the imposition and recovery of any such charges pursuant to Orders made before the coming into force of this Law (*Article 2 and Second Schedule*).

Draft Laws, in similar terms, amending the Telecommunications (Jersey) Law 1972 (P.90/99) and various Laws administered by the Jersey Financial Services Commission on behalf of the Finance and Economics Committee (P.88/99) have also been lodged “au Greffe”. A detailed Report, setting out the background to all three Laws accompanies the latter Proposition.

THE STATES, subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following Law -

ARTICLE 1

Postage charged on postal packets

After paragraph (2) of Article 8 of the Post Office (Jersey) Law 1969,¹ as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), there shall be inserted the following paragraph -

"(2A) In prescribing or otherwise determining postage and other sums payable under this Law, the Committee may take into consideration such matters as it thinks fit, and such postage and other sums may be prescribed or otherwise determined so as to raise income in excess of the amount necessary to cover the expenses of the Committee in discharging its functions under this Law."

Draft Post Office (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Law 199

ARTICLE 2

Validation

The imposition and recovery of postage and other charges pursuant to Orders made, or otherwise determined, under the principal Law before the coming into force of this Law is validated and is to be taken to have been lawfully imposed and recovered.

ARTICLE 3

Short title

This Law may be cited as the Post Office (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Law 199 .
