Report

The Law introduces in the Registration of Business Names (Jersey) Law 1956 standard provisions dealing with -

- (a) the giving of false or misleading information to the Registrar of business names;
- (b) the responsibility of members of limited liability partnerships and officers of bodies corporate for offences under the Law committed by those partnerships or bodies, where such offences are proved to have been committed with the consent or connivance of, or to be attributable to any neglect on the part of members or officers; and
- (c) aiding and abetting the commission of offences.

All offences are punishable by a period of up to five years' imprisonment, or a fine, or both.

The draft Law also makes it clear that if a fee is not paid with an application under the Law, the Registrar can refuse to provide the service applied for and if a periodic fee is not paid, the Registrar may cancel the registration to which the fee relates.

Explanatory Note

The purpose of this Act is to appoint 20th October 2000 as the day for the commencement of the Registration of Business Names (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Law 2000 which was adopted by the States on 22nd February 2000 (P.5 of 2000).

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 2(2) of the Registration of Business Names (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Law 2000,^[1] have made the following Act -

1. The Registration of Business Names (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Law 2000 shall come into force on the twentieth day of October 2000.

2. This Act may be cited as the Registration of Business Names (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Law 2000 (Appointed Day) Act 2000.
