## Report

The changes sought in relation to lighting in P.40/2000 are the same as those sought on P.127/99, lodged "au Greffe" on 14th September 1999 and subsequently withdrawn by the Home Affairs Committee.

Under the Road Transport Lighting Law 1956 disqualification or endorsement of licences was available for second or subsequent offences. Moving the offences in relation to vehicle lighting to Part E of Schedule 1 without limiting the power of disqualification or endorsement to second or subsequent offences only is unnecessary and overly severe.

Substitute the following paragraphs -

- (c) after paragraph 2 of Part E there shall be added the following paragraph -
  - '3. Any offence against an order made under Article 39, being an offence -
    - (a) of contravening or failing to comply with any requirement of an order with respect to lighting equipment and reflectors; or
    - (b) of using a vehicle on a road, causing or permitting a vehicle to be so used, which does not comply with such a requirement,

other than a first offence.'."
