Comments

The Finance and Economics Committee remains gravely concerned that at times of budgetary deficits these proposals are being brought forward which will cost an extra £1.2m a year. The Committee reminds the States that the 2003 cash limits exclude any funding for the Appeals Commission. The earliest that funding for the Appeals Commission can be considered will be in the 2004 Revenue Resource Allocation process.

The Finance and Economics Committee believes that the States should not approve the Draft Planning and Building (Amendment) (Jersey) Law 200, until such a time as the States have determined that this is of sufficient priority for the funding to be included in a future Resource Plan.
