POLICY AND RESOURCES COMMITTEE

REPORT

The Employers' Side membership comprises 6 representatives of the States, one representative of the Parish of St. Helier and one representative of the Connétables. The Committee is satisfied that, based on this year's experience, the work of the Council can be effectively achieved by having only 4 States Representatives, together with the Constable of St. Helier, who represents both that Parish and the Comité de Connétables. The Chief Executive of the States Human Resources Department traditionally fulfils the role of Employers' Side Secretary, and the Director of Employee Relations from the Department becomes the Assistant Employers' Side Secretary.

There are no additional financial or manpower implications for the States arising from this proposition.
