DRAFT FISH HEALTH (AMENDMENT) (JERSEY) REGULATIONS 200-

REPORT

When the Fish Health (Jersey) Regulations 1999 were introduced, the relevant Council Directive provisions under Article 11 were not specified. These Regulations correct the omission.

There are no financial or manpower implications for the States arising from the adoption of these draft Regulations.

Explanatory Note

These Regulations correct an omission in Regulation 11 of the Fish Health (Jersey) Regulations 1999 Regulation 11 requires a person exporting aquaculture animals or products to another place in the British Islands or in the European Economic Community to comply with the requirements of relevant provisions of a Council Directive which is concerned with the marketing of such animals and products. The relevant provisions of the Council Directive were not specified in the 1999 Regulations and this amendment corrects that omission.

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 2 of the European Communities Legislation (Implementation) (Jersey) Law 1996, have made the following Regulations –

1 Fish Health (Jersey) Regulations 1999: Regulation 11 amended

In Regulation 11(2) of the Fish Health (Jersey) Regulations 1999, for the words "are those provisions set out in Part II of the Third Schedule" there shall be substituted the words "are Articles 3, 4, 7 to 11, 14 and 16".

2 Citation and commencement

These Regulations may be cited as the Fish Health (Amendment) (Jersey) Regulations 200- and shall come into force 7 days after they are made.
