Financial/manpower statement

These draft Regulations have no implications for the financial or manpower resources of the States.

Explanatory Note

These Regulations increase the prescribed fees for the grant or renewal of licences under the Licensing (Jersey) Law 1974 by approximately 2.5%.



DRAFT LICENSING (LICENCE FEES) (JERSEY) REGULATIONS 200

Made [date to be inserted] 1st October 2003 Coming into force

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 11 of the Licensing (Jersey) Law 1974, have made the following Regulations –

1 **Increase of Fees**

Subject to paragraphs (2), (3), (4) and (5) of this Regulation, the fees payable on the grant or renewal of licences shall be as follows -

£393 plus a fee of 96p multiplied by the First Category

("Taverner's Licence") maximum number of persons who may at any time be accommodated for reward on the premises (in these Regulations referred to as "the number of approved

residents")

Second Category A fee of 96p multiplied by the number of

("Residential Licence") approved residents, with a minimum fee

of £122

Third Category £393

("Restaurant Licence")

£980 plus a fee of £1.95 multiplied by the Fourth Category

("Comprehensive Licence") number of approved residents

£293 Fifth Category

("Club Licence")

£102 Sixth Category

("Off-Licence")

Seventh Category

("Entertainment Licence")

(a) cinemas, theatres £393

(b) places of entertainment A fee of 96p multiplied by the number of

other than cinemas and persons mentioned in the permit for

theatres

entertainment granted by the Bailiff in respect of the premises, with a minimum fee of £393.

- (2) Where licences of different categories are applicable to the same premises, a separate fee shall be payable in respect of each category of licence.
- (3) Where a licence will expire within 6 months of its commencement, the fee for the licence shall be one-half of that prescribed in paragraph (1).
- (4) Where a licence will expire more than 12 months and 7 days after its commencement, the fee for th licence shall be increased by one-twelfth.
- (5) Where an application for grant of a licence is refused or withdrawn, the amount of the fee shall be refunded to the applicant.

2 Repeal

The Licensing (Licence Fees) (Jersey) Regulations 2002^[2] shall be repealed.

3 Citation and Commencement

These Regulations may be cited as the Licensing (Licence Fees) (Jersey) Regulations 200- and shall come into force on 1st October 2003.
