# DRAFT HARBOURS (AMENDMENT No. 37)(JERSEY) REGULATIONS 200

## Report

In anticipation of the Shipping (Jersey) Law 2002, due to come into force on 1st June 2004, and in recognition of the repeal of the Harbour and Light Dues Law 1947 (as agreed by the States in October 2002), certain amendments are now needed.

Regulation 1 is necessary to ensure there is a continuation of the existing power of the Harbour Master to regulate the time at which vessels berth in the harbour. The Harbour Master's current power in this respect emanates from the Harbour and Light Dues Law 1947 and it is inappropriate to re-instate it in the proposed draft Harbour Charges Law as it is an operational and not a charging issue.

*Regulation 2* is necessary in that the present Regulations require the master of a ship in a harbour to comply with the Collision Regulations made in pursuance of the Merchant Shipping Act 1894, which is to be repealed.

The Committee regard these Regulations as important aspects of ensuring that maritime legislation in Jersey is consistent and effective.

These Draft Regulations have no implications for the financial or manpower resources of the States.

## **Explanatory Note**

These regulations make 2 amendments to the Harbours (Jersey) Regulations 1962 consequential on changed brought about by the Harbour Charges (Jersey) Law and Shipping (Jersey) Law.

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of Article 4 of the Harbours (Administration) (Jersey) Law 1961, have made the following Regulations –

## 1 Regulation 4 amended

In Regulation 4(1)(b) of the Harbours (Jersey) Regulations 1962<sup>[2]</sup> for "the position in which" there shall be substituted "the time at, and the position in which,".

#### 2 Regulation 7 repealed and replaced

Regulation 7 of the Harbours (Jersey) Regulations  $1962^{\boxed{3}}$  is repealed and the following Regulation substituted –

### **"7** Collision regulations

The master of a vessel within a harbour must observe and obey the Regulations for preventing collisions at sea made in pursuance of the Shipping (Jersey) Law 2002. [4],".

#### 3 Citation

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Harbours (Amendment No. 37) (Jersey) Regulations 200.
- (2) They shall come into force on the same day as the Shipping (Jersey) Law 2002.
