DRAFT EDUCATION (PROVIDED SCHOOLS) (JERSEY) REGULATIONS 200

REPORT

These Regulations will replace Part 1 of Schedule 1 to the Education (Jersey) Law 1999 to record-

- (a) the amalgamation of St. Mark's and La Pouquelaye Schools into the new d'Auvergne Primary School, from 1st August 2005;
- (b) the change of name of Le Squez Primary School to Samarés Primary School from 1st September 2004.

There are no financial or manpower implications for the States arising from these draft Regulations.

Explanatory Note

The purpose of these Regulations is to amend the list of provided schools set out in Part 1 of Schedule 1 to the Education (Jersey) Law 1999 to record the amalgamation of St. Mark's Primary School and La Pouquelaye Primary School to form the d'Auvergne Primary School, and the change of the name of Le Squez Primary School to Samarés Primary School.

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 3 of the Education (Jersey) Law 1999,^[1] have made the following Regulations –

1 Schedule 1 amended

For Part 1 of Schedule 1 to the Education (Jersey) Law 1999,^[2] there shall be substituted the Part set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

2 Revocation

The Education (Revocation of Provided School) (Jersey) Regulations 2004^[3] are revoked.

3 Citation, commencement and application

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Education (Provided Schools) (Jersey) Regulations 200-.
- (2) They shall come into force on 1st August 2005.
- (3) Despite paragraph (2), the change of name of Le Squez Primary School to Samarés Primary School shall be taken to have had effect from 1st September 2004.
