The current regulation defines Sole as *Solea solea* and specifies a minimum size of 24 c.m. The amendment seek to broaden the definition of Sole to *Solea spp* to include other members of the Sole species and is consistent with U.K. legislation for the English Channel.

THE STATES, in pursuance of Articles 2, 6 and 8 of the Sea Fisheries (Jersey) Law 1994, ^[1] having consulted with the Secretary of State and obtained the Secretary's concurrence, have made the following Regulations –

1 Schedule amended

In Column 1 of Part 1 of the Schedule to theSea Fisheries (Minimum Size Limits) (Jersey) Regulations 2001^[2] for "Sole (*Solea vulgaris*)" there shall be substituted "Sole (*Solea spp*)".

2 Citation and commencement

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Sea Fisheries (Minimum Size Limits) (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Regulations 200-.
- (2) They shall come into force 7 days after they are made.
