REPORT

This Appointed Day Act relates to three sets of Regulations –

Draft Restriction on Smoking (Vending Machines) (Jersey) Regulations 200- (P.21/2006)

Draft Restriction on Smoking (Public Transport) (Amendment) (Jersey) Regulations 200- (P.22/2006)

Draft Restriction on Smoking (Sales of Cigarettes to Children) (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Regulations 200- (P.23/2006)

Draft Restriction on Smoking (Vending Machines) (Jersey) Regulations 200-

These Regulations restrict where vending machines selling tobacco can be placed in premises where persons under 18 have access. They also restrict the operation of such vending machines at events held wholly or mainly for persons under the age of 18.

Draft Restriction on Smoking (Public Transport) (Amendment) (Jersey) Regulations 200-

These Regulations amend the Restriction on Smoking (Public Transport) (Jersey) Regulations 1982 (which prohibit smoking in public transport) to insert a new offence and increased penalty provision. The current penalty for an offence under the Regulations is a fine not exceeding £50 and, if there is a second conviction, a fine not exceeding £200. The revised penalty is a fine at level 3 on the standard scale (level 3 is £2,000).

Draft Restriction on Smoking (Sales of Cigarettes to Children) (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Regulations 200-

These Regulations amend the Restriction on Smoking (Sales of Cigarettes to Children) (Jersey) Regulations 1992 by inserting a new offence and increased penalty provision. The 1992 Regulations prohibit selling cigarettes to persons under 18 years of age. The current penalty for an offence under the Regulations is a fine not exceeding £50 and, if there is a second conviction, a fine not exceeding £200. The revised penalty is a fine at level 3 on the standard scale (level 3 is £2,000).

Financial/manpower considerations

There are no financial or manpower implications arising from the adoption of this legislation.

Explanatory Note

This Act will bring the provisions of the Restriction on Smoking (Amendment) (Jersey) Law 2006 (apart from Article 8, which dealt with amendments to the Law arising from Ministerial government and which by virtue of the Law itself, comes into force on the same day) into force one month after this Act is made.
