REPORT

These draft Regulations make a minor change to the voter registration form to reflect the reduction in the voting age from 18 to 16. That change will come into effect on 1st April 2008 if the draft Public Elections (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Law 2008 (Appointed Day) Act 200- (P.12/2008) is adopted.

There are no financial or manpower implications for the States.

Explanatory Note

These Regulations amend the Form required to be completed by a person applying for his or her name to be included on the electoral register. The amendment is consequential upon the enactment of the Public Elections (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Law 2007, which lowered the voting age from 18 to 16 years.

1 Schedule to the Public Elections (Jersey) Regulations 2002 amended

In the Schedule to the Public Elections (Jersey) Regulations $2002^{[2]}$, in the 'Instructions to Applicants' included in Form 2, in paragraph 2.(a), for the words "18 years" there shall be substituted the words "16 years".

These Regulations may be cited as the Public Elections (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Regulations 200- and shall come into force on 1st April 2008.
