DRAFT POLICING OF PARKS (AMENDMENT No. 2) (JERSEY) REGULATIONS 201-

REPORT

The Parish of St. Martin has developed a Village Green on an area of land south of St. Martin's Public Hall. The Connétable of St. Martin has requested that the area should be included under Part 1 in the Policing of Parks (Jersey) Regulations 2005. This amendment will designate the area as a 'Park' and as such, enable proper management and policing of the area.

Financial and manpower implications

There are no financial or manpower implications for the States arising from these Draft Regulations.

These Regulations amend the Policing of Parks (Jersey) Regulations 2005.

Regulation 1 and the Schedule amend those Regulations so as to designate St. Martin's Village Green as a park.

Regulation 2 cites the title of these Regulations and provides that they will come into force 7 days after they are made.


1 Amendment of the Policing of Parks (Jersey) Regulations 2005
