## 1 PAGE 19, REGULATION 9 –

In Regulation 9(5) for the words "level 2" substitute the words "level 3".

# 2 PAGE 19, REGULATION 10 -

In Regulation 10(3) for the words "level 3" substitute the words "level 4".

#### REPORT

This amendment would change two maximum penalties in the Draft Harbours (Inshore Safety) (Jersey) Regulations 201- –

- (a) in the case of giving false or misleading information in an application or notice, from level 2 (£500) to level 3 (£2,000);
- (b) in the case of failure to provide information about a serious incident involving a ship or giving false or misleading information about such an incident, from level 3 (£2,000) to level 4 (£5,000).

The amendment would ensure closer harmony with penalties for similar offences in other legislation applying in Jersey.
