DRAFT DENTISTRY (JERSEY) LAW 2015 (APPOINTED DAY) ACT 201-

REPORT

The Draft Dentistry (Jersey) Law 201- was adopted by the States on 22nd September 2015, sanctioned by Order of Her Majesty in Council on 9th December 2015 and registered by the Royal Court on 18th December 2015. The Law has now been published as L.17/2015.

The reasons for the implementation of the new Law are set out in detail in the report attached to <u>P.89/2015</u>. Essentially, it replaces the Dentists (Registration) (Jersey) Law 1961 and enables the classes of dental care professionals currently regulated by the General Dental Council in the U.K. to be registered in Jersey. These are –

- Clinical Dental Technician
- Dental Hygienist
- Dental Nurse
- Dental Technician
- Dental Therapist
- Orthodontic Therapist.

Broadly, the scheme is a secondary registration scheme. That is to say, as long as a dental care professional is authorised to practise in the U.K. by the General Dental Council, the practitioner is also authorised to practise in Jersey.

Financial and manpower implications

There are no additional financial or manpower implications for the States arising from the adoption of this Draft Appointed Day Act. The Law, when in force, will impose additional registration responsibilities on the Professional and Care Regulation Team within the Public Health Directorate, with the additional costs covered by charging a registration fee.



Explanatory Note

This Act brings the Dentistry (Jersey) Law 2015 into force on the day after the Act is made by the States.
