REPORT

After consultation with the Bailiff and the Greffier of the States, I have taken advice to amend the proposition, removing the requirement to refer the matter for the consideration by the Planning Committee, due to a concern that it would not be legal under Article 12(2)(a) of the [Planning and Building \(Jersey\) Law 2002](#).
