Reds benefits to Island





Set out here and in the attached spreadsheet is an analysis of the many benefits derived by the Island of Jersey from professional rugby activity.

Spreadsheet-Playing and Associated activity

- This illustrates the economic benefit of Jersey Reds professional rugby activity in 2022/23. This is one element of the contribution to the island, the others are illustrated below, and aggregated finally to show the overall hard economic benefit.
- You will see that each home game in Championship and Championship Cup has been analysed as to number of visiting playing squad, supporters, bed nights, flights and spend per night in the Island, plus airport revenues per customer. These figures are necessarily judgmental, but are based on discussion with most of the visiting teams' directors as a cross corroboration of visiting attendances etc. The games post—Christmas are always significantly more lucrative, and this year the games against Caldy (their first season in Championship, a major trip for them) Ealing (the Championship decider) and Ampthill (end of season, first proper trip to Jersey post COVID) were particularly positive, as you will see from the numbers included.
- Also included are the revenues associated with the pre-season matches against London Irish, Bath and Leicester, and the England training camp in October 2022, using similar and specific assumptions.



In total the sums included in the spreadsheet at rows headed A, B, C and D are the sum that playing and associated revenues produce, being £2,621,000 each year.

In addition, at row E, the revenues associated with amateur rugby in all its forms and administered by JRFC are arrived at using estimates from JRFC themselves and total a further £832,000. Whilst these revenues are not directly produced by Reds, the services that Reds provide to JRFC provide them with a first-class infrastructure and ensure the continuation of amateur rugby in a form that JRFC could not sustain themselves. Essentially Reds provide services valued at circa £250,000 to JRFC in lieu of rent, such services being currently beyond the JRFC infrastructure to provide themselves. No Reds means JRFC will need to find circa £250,000 more each year, roughly twice their current income.

Other sources of economic benefit to Jersey:

- Taxes to GOJ ITIS and GST £520,000
- Excise duty on bar sales £200,000
- Salary of staff, net of tax £1,300,000, spent on Island.
- Other payments to on Island suppliers, rates, food, alcohol, utilities etc. £,400,000
- Total other sources £,2,420,000

Summary benefit to island from Reds professional activities:

- Playing and Associated Activity £2,621,000
- Total Other Sources £,2,420,000

Grand total direct benefit £5,041,000



Applying a multiplier of 1.3x gives £6,553,000 aggregate benefit to Island in 2022/23 season.

An economic multiplier is a commonly used assumption to give effect to the fact that once one person spends a £1 there is a trickle-down effect from the recipient's subsequent expenditure. Standard procedure.

In addition, there is the £832,000 (£1,081,000 after 1.3x multiplier) contributed by JRFC amateurs, which are not included in the above numbers for Reds

Soft benefits

Jersey Reds are now an iconic Jersey brand.

The PR and reputational benefit for Jersey derived from Reds' success is material. We do not have analysis of this, but for reference the PR value to Jersey in equivalent media spend terms for the British and Irish Lions training camp in 2021 alone was publicly estimated by Visit Jersey at £6,000,000.

It is not suggested that Reds normal activities generate this amount, but nevertheless the benefit is in multiple millions of Pounds per annum. Further we have not estimated the social benefit and 'halo effect' for Mini and Junior participation in rugby in part due the Reds being involved in those activities and providing role models.
