

**WRITTEN QUESTION TO THE MINISTER FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT BY DEPUTY G.C.L.
BAUDAINS OF ST. CLEMENT**

ANSWER TO BE TABLED ON TUESDAY 1st APRIL 2008

Question

Would the Minister advise whether Jersey Harbours have any plans to relocate the fuel farm and, if so, in what timescale?

Answer

The Economic Development Department, Jersey Harbours and the Waterfront Enterprise Board (WEB) are, as part of a strategic planning process, undertaking a master planning exercise for the East of Albert area that includes the site of the current fuel port and La Collette. A key component of the process is the possibility of relocating the existing commercial port to La Collette to allow commercial and residential development in the current operational port area to satisfy future demand for quality residential and commercial space in St Helier. As part of the process to assess the viability and implications of port relocation, the future location of the fuel port is being considered. The timescale for relocation, which would be subject to health and safety, environmental and commercial considerations has yet to be determined.
