

**WRITTEN QUESTION TO THE CHIEF MINISTER
BY DEPUTY R.G. LE HÉRISSEIER OF ST. SAVIOUR
ANSWER TO BE TABLED ON TUESDAY 16th APRIL 2013**

Question

“When is it intended to present the next activity report relating to public sector salaries over £100,000 (as agreed in P.59/2011)?”

Answer

P.59/2011 requires the States Employment Board (SEB) to make a quarterly report on applications for the recruitment to appointments with salaries over £100,000. The last report presented in March 2012 covered applications made during 2011.

There had been insufficient activity to merit reporting on a quarterly basis, a judgement was therefore made to report on an annual basis. The P.59 report for 2012 is due to be reviewed by the SEB at their next meeting in May and will be presented to the States as soon as possible thereafter. SEB will also review the reporting time basis.
