ANSWER TO BE TABLED ON MONDAY 2nd NOVEMBER 2020**

**Question**

Will the Minister provide details of the percentage of instances since 1st October 2020 in which a positive Covid test result has been received on Day 5, or any subsequent day, following an initial negative Covid-test result?

**Answer**

Between 1<sup>st</sup> October and 27<sup>th</sup> October 2020, there were a total of 139 positive Covid tests (based on swab date). Of these 139, 17.2% were positive on either day 5, or day 8, having had a previous negative test result.
