- (a) the total number of civil servants currently employed in the civil service;
- (b) the number of staff equivalent to civil servants currently employed in the States wholly-owned subsidiaries;
- (c) the number of new posts created in the past 6 months within both the civil service and whollyowned subsidiaries;
- (d) the job descriptions of any such new posts;
- (e) the number of civil service employees who have left the service in the past 6 months; and
- (f) the number of civil service equivalent employees in the wholly-owned subsidiaries who have left in the past 6 months?

- b) The States wholly-owned subsidiaries do not employ staff as civil servants or as equivalents to civil servants
