Report

On 24th February 2000, the Home Affairs Committee made an Act delegating certain of its functions under the Motor Vehicles (Construction and Use) (Jersey) Order 1998.

The terms of the delegation were recorded in an Act of the Committee as follows -

"A25. The Committee, in pursuance of Article 36A of the States of Jersey Law 1966, as amended, decided wit immediate effect, to delegate to the Inspector of Motor Traffic, under Article 120(2) of the Motor Vehicles (Construction and Use) (Jersey) Order 1998, as follows -

Legislation: Motor Vehicles (Construction and Use)

(Jersey) Order 1998, Article 120(2).

Delegate: The Inspector of Motor Traffic.

Function delegated: To designate persons to examine

vehicles and issue certificates of compliance under Article 120(2) and if an examiner failed to carry out his functions satisfactorily to remove that designation under sub-paragraph (5) of

Article 120.

Scope of delegation: If a vehicle testing scheme was to be

introduced, this would enable designated examiners to be appointed and, if unsatisfactory, to remove that

designation.

The Greffier of the States was requested to arrange for this Act to be presented to the States for information.".
