## REPORT

On 5th November 2003, the Finance and Economics Committee made an Act delegating certain of its functions under the Public Finances (General) (Jersey) Rules 1967, as amended.

The terms of the delegation were recorded in an Act of the Committee as follows –

“A11. The Committee, with reference to its Act No. A10 of this meeting, considered a Treasury Paper dated 21st October 2003 concerning a proposal for the delegation of a function under Rule 5AA of the Public Finances (General) (Jersey) Rules 1967, as amended, to the Treasurer of the States.

The Committee, in pursuance of Article 36A of the States of Jersey Law 1966, as amended, delegated to those referred to in a formal statement (designated Committee Paper FE/39/03) that function listed.

The Committee decided that the abovementioned delegation would have effect from 5th November 2003.

The Greffier of the States was directed to arrange for a copy of this Act to be presented to the States for their information.”.
