STATES OF JERSEY LAW 2005: DELEGATION OF FUNCTIONS – LOANS TO BEAULIEU CONVENT SCHOOL

REPORT

On 18th December 2007, the Minister for Treasury and Resources made a decision delegating certain of his functions under Article 28 of the States of Jersey Law 2005 in respect of the Public Finances (Transitional Provisions) (No. 2) (Jersey) Regulations 2005.

The terms of the delegation are as follows –

Public Finances

Legislation:	Public Finances (Transitional Provisions) (No. 2) (Jersey) Regulations 2005.
Delegate:	The Assistant Minister for Treasury and Resources.
Function delegated:	The Minister's authority to lend money in the name of and on behalf of the States.
Scope of delegation:	The delegation is only in respect of any loans to Beaulieu Convent School during the period the Minister holds the position of Chairman of the Board of Trustees for the School.
