## REPORT

On 5th June 2024, the Minister for Health and Social Services made a Ministerial Decision delegating certain of his functions under Articles 28, 30 and 30A of the [States of Jersey Law 2005](#) (see Decision reference MD-HSS-2024-452, available at [www.gov.je](http://www.gov.je)).

Article 28 of the States of Jersey Law 2005 permits a Minister to delegate, wholly or partly, functions to an Assistant Minister or an officer.

The terms of the delegations, and the legislation under which those delegations were made, were recorded in a Report attached to the Ministerial Decision, as shown below –

<b>Delegate:</b>	Deputy Andy Howell of St John, St Lawrence and Trinity
<b>Functions delegated:</b>	The Minister delegated responsibility for Women’s Health policy to his Assistant Minister including the following functions: Standing Order 9(3) – answering questions; Standing Order 17(1)(a) – making statements; Standing Order 19(c) – lodging Propositions; Standing Order 35(1)(b) – presenting Reports or Comments; Standing Order 68A(3) – proposing Propositions
