



Canbedone Productions Grant

The Public Accounts Committee is continuing with its review into a £200,000 grant provided by the Economic Development Department to a company intending to shoot part of a film in the Island. Deputy Tracey Vallois, the Chairman of the PAC stated:

“It has come to my attention that there have been threats and unpleasant comments made towards the Chief Officer of Economic Development and his family during our review over the Film Grant of £200,000. Although we understand the concern from the public over the governance and amount of money issued, the Public Accounts Committee would like to make it clear that we do not condone threats being made at any level towards Public Sector Employees.

We are yet to complete our evidence based review into this matter and therefore are not in a position to detail and explain the outcome at this point. Once our review has been completed the public will be able to have access to our report via the States Bookshop or the Scrutiny website www.scrutiny.gov.je.”

The Committee is completing the review and the report is expected to be published in the middle of March.
